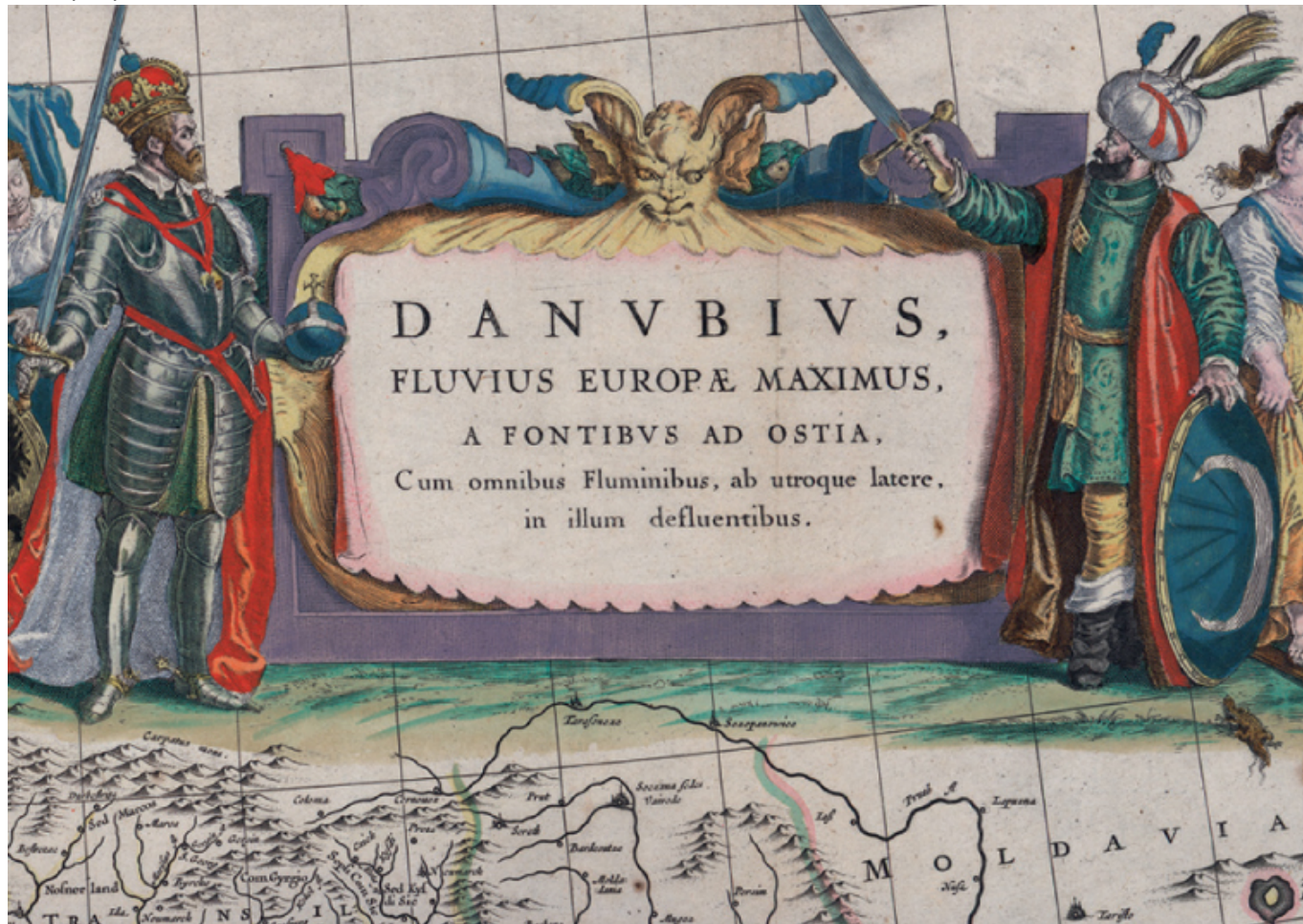


## **CHANGING SPACES. The Danube region on historical maps - exhibition opening ceremony**
