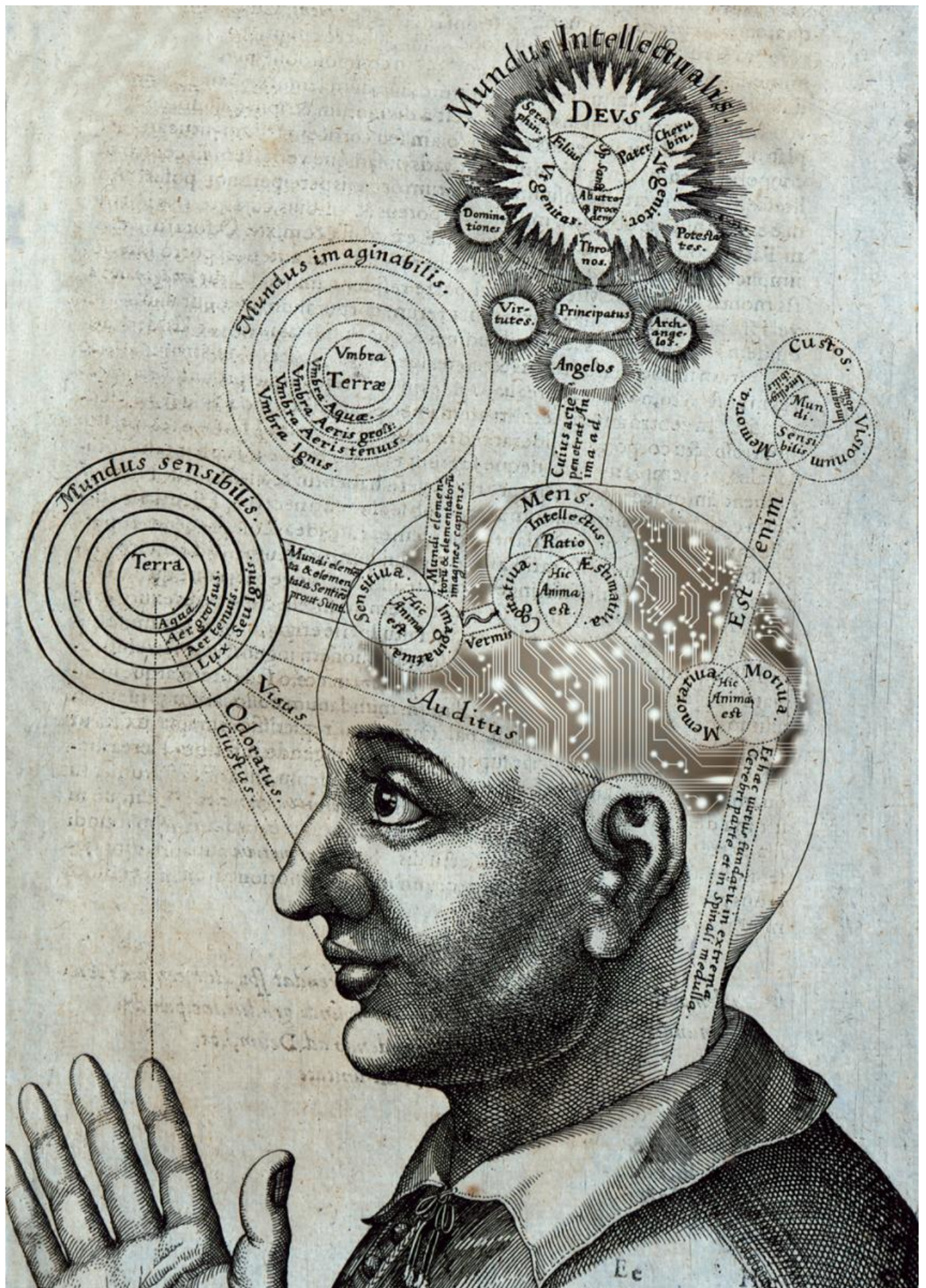


[1] **Culture historical exhibition of The Ritman Library in National Széchényi Library**
